Parking lot is now complete



The Village Community Center Parking lot is now complete. Please take note that you can enter the village parking area from North Street or North Military Street. The ***"NO PARKING" in front of the Fire Department Overhead Doors*** will be strictly enforced. The Fire

Department can get called out at any time. A vehicle parked in front of the doors will not have time to move before a truck leaves the garage.

Parking for Village Hall vehicles is on the east side of the building and in the rear of the building. Parking spaces on the west side of the building are reserved for the Fire Department Volunteers.

Just a reminder:

Winter Parking begins on November 15, 2015 and continues through March 15, 2016. On Street Parking is restricted from 2 a.m. until 6 a.m. every day. Tickets will be issued to all cars left on the street especially during a snow event.



Brush Pick Up

Brush pickup is the **second Tuesday of every month**. Brush should be laid on the curb with the cut end towards the curb and in a neat pile.

Delinquent Water Sewer Bills



Unpaid balances of Water and Sewer accounts will be transferred to real estate property tax bills on November 1, 2015. All tenants should plan to get their water and sewer bills paid current by October 31, 2015 to avoid the 10% penalty. Letters regarding this issue will be mailed to delinquent account holders and property owners by October 15, 2015.

Once Dane County is notified about the past due balance it cannot be changed. Landlords will be notified of tenants past due balances on October 15, 2015 too.
