

Notice of Rate Increase
Water Customers of the Dane Water and Sewer Utility

This is to give you notice that the Dane Water and Sewer Utility will file an application on August 9, 2023, with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC), for authority to increase water rates. Rates for general service will increase 8.0 percent. The increase is necessary to reduce the existing deficiency in present rates. The request is being made under Wis. Stat. 196.193. Rate increases granted under this statute do not require a public hearing. The effect of the increase for some selected customers is shown below. Public Fire Protection and Wholesale rates (if applicable) will also increase 8.0 percent.

DELINQUENT BALANCES ON UTILITY BILLS



The Dane Water and Sewer Bills are sent to residents monthly. The due date is clearly stated on the bill. It is expected that all balances be paid monthly by each utility customer. Any balance owed after the due date is subject to a 1% interest charge. This adds up to an annual percentage rate of 12% on unpaid balances. All accounts with past due balances will receive a notice in mid-October. The balance will need to be paid in full by October 31, 2023. Any outstanding amounts on November 1st will have an additional 10% penalty added and the full amount will be transferred to the real estate property tax bill by 11/15/2023. Please pay your outstanding utility balance as soon as possible.
