UNPAID WATER SEWER ACCOUNTS WILL BE DISCONNECTED STARTING IN JUNE

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin oversees public water utilities, like the Village of Dane. The PSC requires utility accounts with past due balances to have the service shut off until the bill is paid. Delinquent customers will receive a first-class notice in the mail about 10 days after the due date, if the account remains delinquent, it will be tagged for disconnection 10 days after that. If you are a water sewer customer in the habit of not paying your water sewer bill, **please be prepared to have the water service shut off. If you need to make a payment arrangement to bring your account current**, please contact the Village Clerk's office. Once your water is shut off, the reconnection charge will be \$25-\$50 and the account must be paid in full.

SEVERE WEATHER AND BRANCH PICK UP

The severe weather that has impacted the village over the last couple of weeks has caused many trees to lose their branches. The Public Works Crew will collect limbs and branches in **EMERGENCY SITUATIONS**, as needed. The scheduled pick-up day is the second Tuesday of the month. All the same rules apply to regular pick up and emergencies. The ordinance regarding this topic is printed on the back of the newsletter. **PLEASE read it carefully and abide by the guidelines.** You may have one yard or one tree branch to deal with, but the PW Crew has the entire village to look after, piling the branches as required will assist in a cleaner, quicker collection throughout the village. **Branches and limbs are NEVER** to be left at the Public Works Garage!
