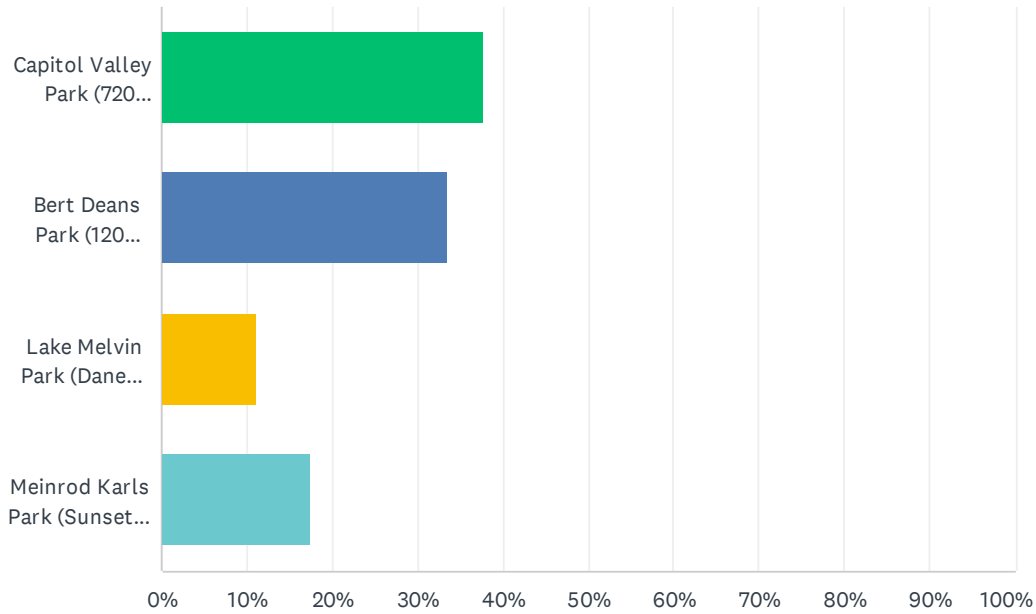

Q19 What is your favorite park to visit in the Village of Dane?

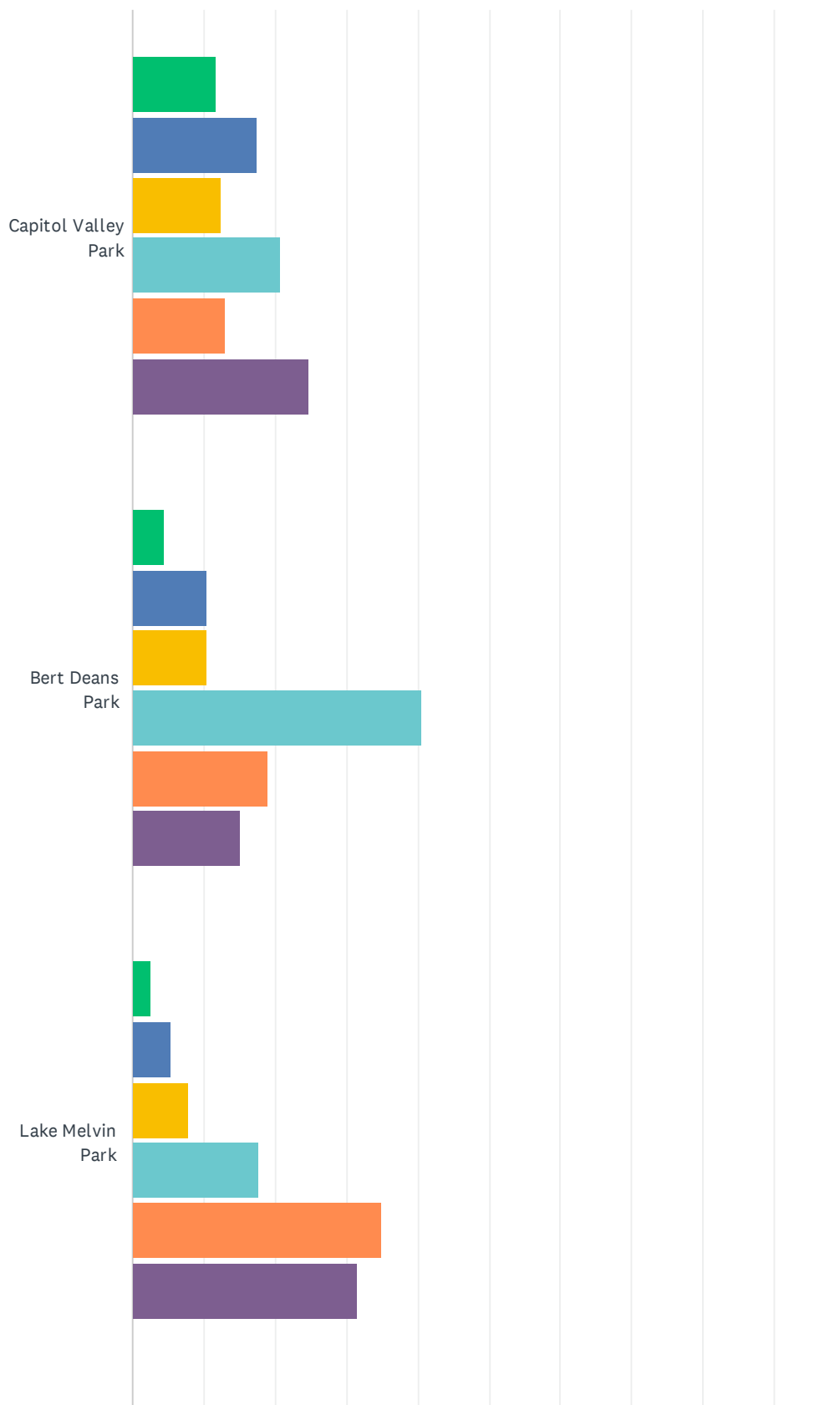

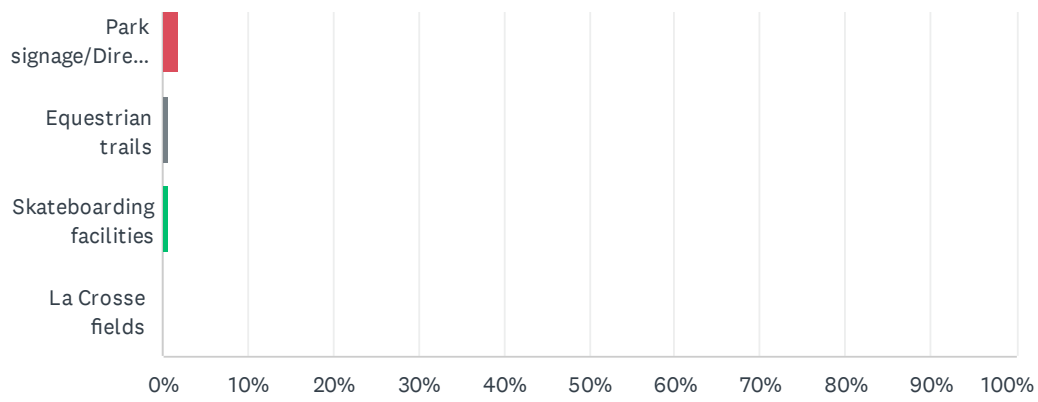

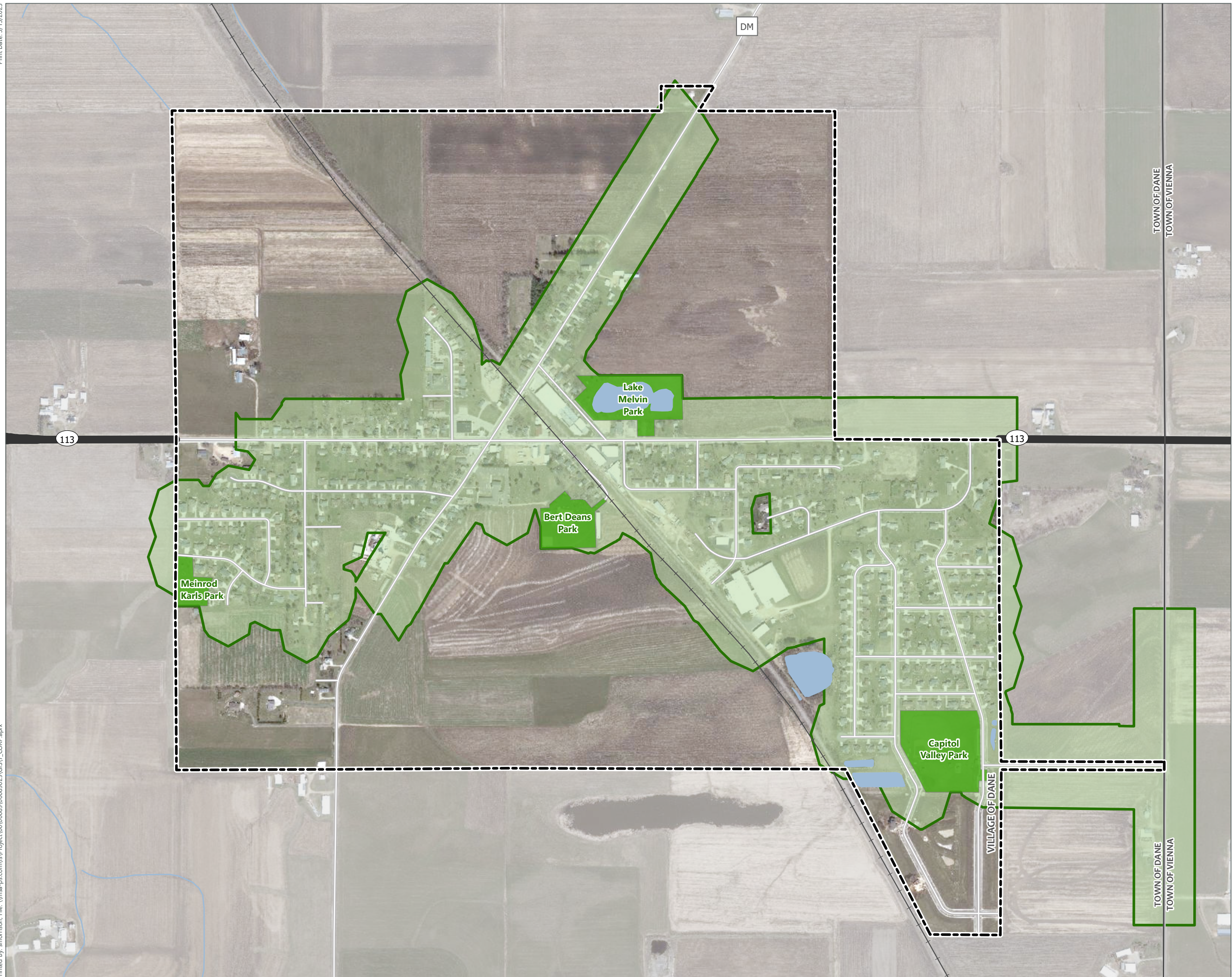

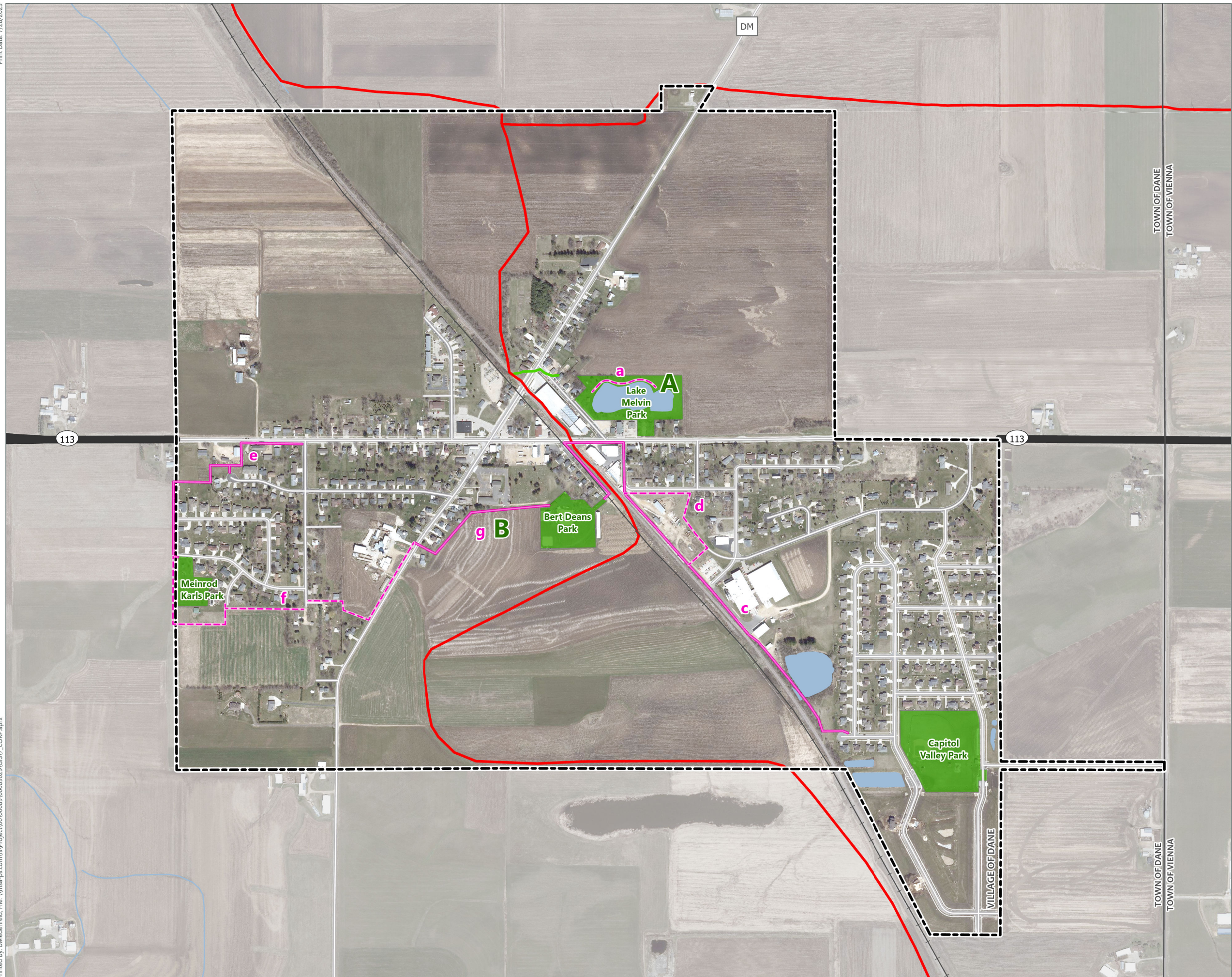
