

Welcome Spring, we have been waiting for you...

Lawn compost may be taken to the Public Works Garage anytime. Be sure to add your compost to the pile that is already at the Public Works Building. There is no need to make separate piles and please, no sticks, limbs, branches, or logs of any kind are to be added to the pile.



Brush pick up will be on the second Tuesday of each month. Limbs, branches and large sticks can be left on the curb with the ends facing the street. The Public Works Department may charge property owners if excess amounts of limbs or branches are left for pick up.

2015 Assessments have been completed by Associated Appraisal Consultants, Inc. Letters were sent to any property owner whose valuation was adjusted. The Property Assessment List will be available in the clerk's office after Board of Review. Copies are available for a fee.

Dog licenses issued after April 1 each year carry an additional \$20 late fee. All dogs residing in the Village of Dane are required by Ordinance Chapter 197-3 to be licensed.

*Also according to Chapter 197-6 no animal, cat or dog, is allowed to be **at large** in the village of Dane. Please do not allow your pet(s) to roam the village without supervision or in your control.*



Displaying your house or building number clearly, in plain sight, and easy to read from the road is very important for anyone attempting to identify your location. The Village of Dane **Ordinance Chapter 457-16** says:

A. Buildings to have street numbers. Each principal building in the Village shall be assigned to an official street number by the Village Clerk-Treasurer. All lots and parts of lots in the Village shall be numbered in accordance with a street numbering map on file in the office of the Village Clerk-Treasurer. Plats shall be numbered to conform as nearly as possible to the general scheme of numbering as outlined on the map.

B. Street numbers to be displayed. The owner, occupant or agent in charge of the premises shall cause to be affixed and to be maintained when so affixed to each principal building controlled by him the official street number assigned to that building as provided in Subsection A hereof. The physical numbers provided herein shall be numerical and shall be not less than three inches high on a background of not less than three inches. Each required number shall be affixed on the particular building in such a location that it may be easily and readily seen by a person of ordinary eyesight on the public street or highway upon which the building abuts. For buildings abutting also on a public alley, the street number shall also be affixed in such location that it may be seen in like manner from such alley. Multiple units and multiple structures on a lot at a single street address shall be designated with the suffix "A," "B," etc.

C. Noncompliance. If the owner or occupant of any building neglects for 20 days to duly attach and maintain the proper numbers on the building, the Village shall serve him a notice requiring him to properly number the same, and if he neglects to do so for 10 days after service, he shall be subject to a forfeiture as provided in § 1-4 of this Code.

If your street number does not comply with the village ordinances, please upgrade your number according to the information provided here as soon as possible.

Thank you for your attention to this important aspect of property identification.
