Remember, Village Ordinances do not allow **burning this time of year** except for **recreational enjoyment**. Citations may be issued by the Dane Police for burning outside of designated times.



The saying, “**love me, love my dog**” does not apply when your pet is allowed to damage other’s property. Village Ordinance **Chapter 197-10** specifically state: **“It shall be unlawful for any person owning or possessing an animal, dog or cat to permit such animal, dog or cat to go upon any parkway or private lands or premises without the permission of the owner of such premises and break, bruise, tear up, crush or injure any lawn, flowerbed, plant, shrub, tree or garden in any manner whatsoever or to defecate thereon.** This is a reminder that Dane Police will issue citations if your dog does damage to other’s property or if you do not clean up your pets feces from someone else’s property. Also, Village Ordinances state that **DOGS are not allowed in village parks** at any time. If you happen to be a dog owner that uses the park to exercise your dog be aware that citations will be issued for this ordinance violation as well.



Maintaining the terrace (the area between sidewalk and road) is each homeowner /property owner’s responsibility. If the Public Works Department mows your terrace, it will cost \$75 each time. **Ordinance Chapter 457-11** covers this information. Check it out!
