NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Dane Village Board will hold a public hearing on **MONDAY, JUNE 1, 2015**, at Dane Village Hall, beginning at 6:30 p.m. to hear comments on an amendment to the 2011-2031 Village of Dane Comprehensive Plan. The amendment to the “Future Land Use

Map” will be reviewed by the Village Plan Commission at a meeting on Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at 6:30 pm. The Plan Commission may make a recommendation to the Village Board of Trustees for adoption of the amendment. The Village Board will consider adoption of the amendment following the public hearing. The amendment to the comprehensive plan indicates a zoning change of parcel 302 E Main Street from Public & Institutional to Industrial. Upcoming Events in the Village of Dane

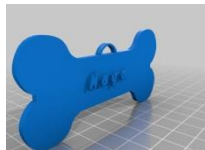

Village of Dane Ordinance #197-3 requires all dog residing in the village be licensed. If you are out of compliance, enforcement tickets will be issued by mail. If you have lost a pet or your pet has found a new home, it is important to report this information to the clerk’s office so the records can be updated.

It shall be unlawful for any person in the Village of Dane to own, harbor or keep any dog more than five months of age without complying with the provisions of §§ 174.05 through 174.10, Wisconsin State Statutes, relating to the listing, licensing and tagging of the same. The owner of any dog more than five months of age on January 1 of any year, or five months of age within the license year, shall annually, or on or before the date the dog becomes five months of age, pay a license tax and obtain a license.
