Sewer Rate Increase

Yes, sewer rates have increased with this bill. However, the rate increase should have only a small impact on the each customer. The base monthly rate changed

from \$15.75 on a standard ¾ inch household meter to \$16.54 per month and the charge for the usage fee changed from \$6.31 to \$6.63 per 1,000 gallons. Monthly bills will show increases as follows:

Did you remember to license your dog this year?

Annual Dog License Renewal begins each year in January. All dogs residing in the Village that are over the age of 5 months **MUST BE** licensed. In order for the tags to be issued rabies vaccine certificates must be presented annually. Spayed or neutered dog tags are \$10.00 and male or female dog tags are \$15.00. A late fee of \$20 per dog will be added after March 31. Please complete the form as accurately and completely as possible. Forms are available online or in the Clerk's Office.
