You will receive a confirmation and follow up email after your information is received and the request has been completed. This option is much quicker than trying to call.



### SENIOR CENTER OF WAUANKEE

The Village of Dane supports the Senior Center of Waunakee. The Center offers many activities from special holiday meals, trips, foot clinics and fun classes. The Center is located at 333 S. Madison Street in Waunakee.

The Center also offers Case Management Services for seniors living in the village of Dane. Case Management Assistance is available to individuals age 60 and older. Services include information, resources, and support for older

adults and their families. Some individuals are looking for short term information, while others benefit from support. Dane residents and their families are encouraged to use this valuable service and to enjoy the Senior Center.



### HAVE YOU LICENSED YOUR DOG?

Don't forget to license your dog before March 31, 2019 to save the late fee of \$20. This fee is added on April 1. All dogs 5 months old and up who reside in the village need to be licensed annually. A completed application and a current rabies certificate need to be submitted to the Clerk's office for a tag to be issued. Fees are \$10 or \$15 dollars.

The polls open at 7 am and close at 8 pm. All residents living in the village vote at the Community Center located at 102 W. Main Street. Please bring your photo ID when you come to vote. You can register at the polls on

### DANE COUNTY DEPUTY CONTRACT

The Village of Dane and the Town of Westport have agreed to share one full-time Dane County Deputy. Beginning March 17, 2019, Deputy Brad Duffrin will be the Village of Dane's assigned deputy. He will be driving the Dane squad and working out of the Dane Police Department Office.
