DO I NEED A BUILDING PERMIT?

Best practice is to check and be sure before you start any project. Building Permits are required for many types of building repairs or new construction work. Driveways,

fences, siding, furnace replacement, water heaters, sunrooms, decks, and basement finishing or remodeling all require a building permit. Know before you start your project! Check village ordinances online at the village website or call the Clerk's office for assistance.

If you do not have a permit that was obtained from the village of Dane Board of Trustees you are not allowed to use Fireworks. If you are not one of the types of groups able to obtain a permit, do not light up, shoot off or plan to use any kind of fireworks this summer. Citations will be issued. Parents of children under 18 years of age are responsible for any illegal activity. Thank you for your concern for safety in the Village of Dane.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING



With carted curbside recycling collection all items can be placed loose and separately in your cart. It is especially important that you do not place plastic bags or plastic food wrap in with your recycling items. Plastic bags cause a significant problem for the vast majority of

processing facilities in Wisconsin. Plastic grocery bags can be taken to designated retail drop-off locations around the area.
