WISCONSIN RECYCLING COMPANY



This privately owned recycling company has a collection site in Lodi every Saturday from 10 am to noon on the corner of Hwy 113 and Hwy J.

They accept ALL ALUMINUM like cans, foil, pots, pans, doors, windows, and chairs. Please remove glass, metal screws, plastic or wood parts. They accept copper, brass, car, truck and tractor batteries, Christmas lights and all electrical wire.

They also will recycle all scrap metal and the following appliances at NO CHARGE: washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, vacuum cleaners, hair dryers, toasters, mixers, curling irons, computer hard drives, bicycles, lawn mowers, gas grills and car parts- EVERYTHING METAL -They DO NOT accept televisions or computer monitors. For a better future, please recycle.

BACK TO SCHOOL



Kids are back in school the beginning of September so drivers, please, obey flashing lights in bus loading zones – stopping is mandatory when red lights are flashing- no matter what! Please remember that there will be buses coming to the Village of Dane to pick up and drop off students who go to

Lodi Schools. Whether you have children who ride the bus or not, you must follow safe driving habits and pay attention to school bus loading and unloading zones. **The intersection of South Street and West Street is a School Bus Zone.** If the bus is there, with the red lights flashing and the stop arm out, you have to stop! It does not matter which direction you are coming from or where you are headed! Be aware of all bus stop zones in the Village!

A **bus stop zone is on North Military Road** just south of the railroad tracks. In this area the bus, by ordinance, uses the yellow hazard lights, and is to be pulled closer to the curb when it stops. At this stop zone, and this one only, cars may continue to drive past the bus in a safe and cautious manner. No child should be in or near the roadway when you proceed past this bus area.
