DELINQUENT BALANCES ON UTILITY BILLS

The Village of Dane Water and Sewer Bills are sent to residents on a monthly basis. The due date is clearly stated on the bill. It is expected that balances will be paid monthly by each utility customer. Any balance owed after the due date is subject to a 1% interest charge. This adds up to an annual percentage rate of 12% on unpaid balances. All accounts with past due balances will receive notices in mid-October. The balance will need to be paid in full by October 31, 2020. Any outstanding amounts will have an additional 10% penalty added and the full amount will be transferred to the real estate property tax bill by 11/15/2020. If you have gotten into the bad habit of not paying your utility bill each month, then you can expect to begin receiving disconnection notices in the mail. Once a notice is received you will have 10 days to pay the amount due or risk disconnection of your water service.

FALL BURNING


Leaves, grass, and garden waste can be burned from October 1 through November 15 each year. According to the ordinance, burning can be done from 6 pm to 6 am Monday through Saturday. Burning is never allowed on Sundays. All such burning should be done in a legal and safe manner and no such fires shall be left unattended.

VOTE ABSENTEE

Do not forget the General Election is November 3, 2020. If you would like to request an absentee ballot just go to the myvote.wi.gov or call the Clerk's office. Either way you must provide a picture id to vote absentee. You can also vote early anytime starting on October 19 thru October 30. Please call the Clerk's office before stopping by to vote.

If you do request an absentee ballot, you can monitor the progress of your ballot on myvote.wi.gov. If you feel your ballot is missing, please contact the Clerk's office and we can reissue you a new one.

MULCH, COMPOST, BRUSH!!

Mulch is available for residents at the Public Works Garage. Please take what you can use. Please do not drop brush, branches, or tree limbs off at the Public Works Garage! Pick up is the second Tuesday of each month.

HYDRANTS WILL BE FLUSHED IN OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER

The Public Works Department will be exercising valves on the fire hydrants throughout October and November. This means that you could find air in your water lines, lower water pressure during the time the hydrant is being worked on, or discolored water when any faucet is first used after the hydrant work has been done.
