## Tree Pick Up:

Trees are being picked up on a regular basis. If your tree is on the curb, it will be picked up. Please be sure it is the tree ONLY. Please do not leave anything wrapped around the tree, like lights!

## If you think you have a gas leak or smell natural gas:

- Leave the area IMMEDIATELY and evacuate everyone from the home or building.
- Go to a remote location, and call your gas provider.
- If gas is blowing, also call 911.
- Move quickly: Don't stop to look for the leak or open windows. You can ventilate your home later.
- Do not use anything that might create a spark, such as a cellphone, light switch or garage door opener. These can ignite gases or vapors.



## Disposing of PINECONES:



If you have collected pinecones from your yard, you can put them into the trash container or burn them in the spring and fall when burning is allowed. Please do not put pinecones in the compost pile.
