This month we are highlighting the parks located in the Village of Dane:

Mienrod Karls Park is a 2 acre park located at the end of Sunset Drive on the west side of the village. This park offers a picnic shelter with tables, a portable restroom from June –August, a playground area, basketball court, and a 1 acre grass recreation area.



Lake Melvin Park is a 7 acre park located along Dane Street in the center of the village on the north side. This park offers a picnic shelter with tables, fishing for all ages, and a beautiful view of the area.



Capitol Valley Park is a 9 acre park located between Valley Road and Capitol Drive at the intersection of Capitol Drive and Capitol Valley Way. This park offers a picnic shelter and tables, a concession building with lights and power outlets, public restrooms, a playground area for young children, baseball field with bleachers and an electronic scoreboard, also available are two 1.5 acre grass recreation areas.



Bert Deans Park is a 5 acre park located at the end of Railroad Street in the center of the village on the south side. This park features a large picnic shelter with tables, lights and power outlets, a small shelter with lights, power outlets, and restrooms, a concession building with electric coolers, lights, power outlets and a restroom. This park also features a playground area, softball field with bleachers, scoreboard and lights, plus a T-ball field with bleachers and lights. This park is available to rent for family reunions, birthday and graduation parties, and baseball tournaments.
