### Voter Registration Cards

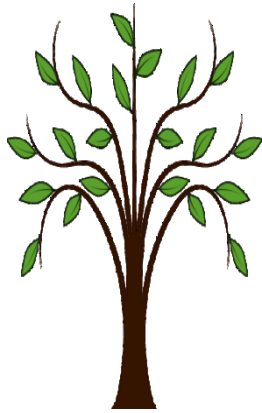


Many of you have received an Application for Continuation of Registration card in the mail. The Wisconsin Elections Commission mails cards every four (4) years for residents to verify that you still live at your current address. If you received a card in the mail,

please sign, date, and return it to the Village Clerk's Office as soon as possible.

### Planting Trees

Planting the correct trees in the right places conserves energy and reduces your electric bill, it could also help fight climate change, provide summer shade, winter warmth and winter windbreaks. It is important to always call Diggers Hotline to have your yard marked before you make the final decision on where to plant those new trees.



- Deciduous trees, planted on the south and west sides, will keep your house cool in the summer by creating soothing shade from the hot summer sun and reduces summer air conditioning costs by up to 35%. They also let the sun warm your home in the winter, reducing energy use.
- Just three trees, properly placed around a house, can save up to 30% of energy use.
- Trees or shrubs planted to shade air conditioners help cool a building more efficiently, using less electricity. A unit operating in the shade uses as much as 10% less electricity than the same one operating in the sun.
- Trees planted to shade patios, sidewalks, and driveways, cool the concrete, the entire yard, and even the neighborhood.

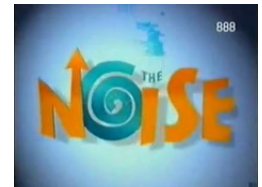
### WATER QUALITY REPORT
