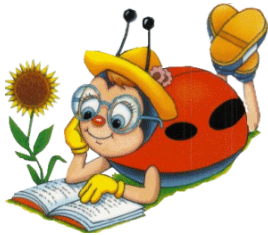
**Brush Pickup is the second Tuesday of the month ONLY.**

**Do not** bring tree limbs, brush, sticks or twigs to the PW Garage on Snyder Drive. Brush must not be placed on the compost piles. All brush should be placed on the curb in front of your house a day before the second Tuesday of the month for pick up.

**Compost Piles at PW Garage** - there is a process to composting; therefore, it is very important that all residents follow the directions posted at the compost site and place your compost materials on the proper pile. **Please do not add brush, twigs, limbs, or branches to any compost pile.**



If you are leaving compost material at the site, it must be added to the correct pile. **Do not leave materials in front or beside the pile - PUT IT ON THE PILE!**

**Open Trustee Position**

Scott Smith has given his resignation as a Village Trustee to President Roger Schmidt. His position is vacant as of May 29, 2017. The term does not expire until April 2018. Anyone interested in being considered for this position should write a brief letter of interest, including your background and why you are interested in serving on the Village Board. All letters need to be received by the Village Clerk no later than Thursday, June 22, 2017. The position will be filled through a recommendation by the Board President and a majority vote of the Trustees.

The Village Board took action to acquire the property at 107 and 109 North Military Road in a Closed Session meeting on April 20, 2017. The plan is to remove the building in the next few weeks. The lots are part of the TIF #2 Downtown Development Plan. The plan details can be found on the village website. More information will be shared as the Village Board decides the potential development of these parcels.
