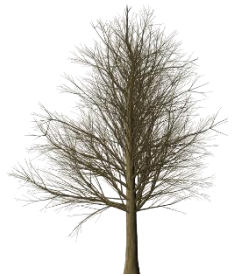
ELECTRONIC RECYCLING EVENT



Mark your calendar - Saturday, August 14, 2021 for the Second Recycling Event in the Village of Dane. In November 2020, at the first event, we recycled 545 pounds of Batteries, 127 pounds of Wire, 925 pounds of CPUs, 1,191 pounds of Freon, 3,330 pounds of TVs, 3,440 pounds of Steel and 1,082 pounds of Electronics! Great job keeping all those pounds from a landfill!
