FIRE HYDRANTS

Thank you to everyone who took the time and care to keep the fire hydrants clear of ice and snow.

THE THREE P's

Flush only the 3 P's (poo, pee, TP!) Even if it says 'flushable', wipes can cause major problems for wastewater systems. Please #LoveYourPipes by not flushing any sort of disposable wipes or anything else down the toilet!!

TOILETS ARE NOT TRASHCANS

Avoid flushing anything except for human waste and toilet paper. Everything else is 'non-flushable.'

Although some things like wet wipes, or medicines may physically go down the toilet, it does not mean they should. Protect your home and the village infrastructure, use trash cans for everything other than the 3 P's!



LICENCE YOUR FOUR-LEGGED FRIENDS

All dogs should be licensed by March 31, 2021 to avoid paying a late fee on your dog registration. Tags are mandated by village ordinances and Wisconsin State Statutes. Dogs are to be licensed annually and must have a tag on their collar to enter the parks. Not purchasing a license/tag is a violation and citations can be issued to owners of unlicensed dogs.



VILLAGE BOARD ADOPTS NEW ORDINANCE REGARDING PETS IN VILLAGE PARKS

The Village Board of Trustees adopted a new pet friendly park ordinance at the regular meeting on March 2, 2021. The new ordinance will be posted to the website this week.
