Winter Parking begins on November 15, 2017 and continues daily until March 15, 2018. The rule is “**No Parking on any village street from 2 am until 6 am**”. This allows the Public Works Crew time to properly remove snow and salt/sand the roadways, parking areas and sidewalks. Parking fines are \$25 if your vehicle is left on the street overnight. Thanks for obeying this important rule.



Illegal Dumping

Village Ordinances Chapter 457.14 covers Unlawful Dumping in Village Streets. This ordinance applies to streets, dead ends and cul-de-sacs. Also, there should be no parking of trailers, boats or extra vehicles or the placement of basketball hoops and other sports equipment in these areas. The ordinance reads as follows: *“It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit or cause to be deposited, dump, sort, scatter or leave any rubbish, stone, wire, earth, ashes, cinders, sawdust, hay, glass, manure, filth, paper, snow, ice, dirt, grass, leaves, construction waste, garbage or other offensive or noxious material in any public street, sidewalk, or alley or upon any public property or upon any property of another without the express permission of the owner or occupant thereof.”*



Real Estate and Personal Property

Composting at the Public Works Garage



When you are taking compost material to the Public Works Garage, please be sure you are adding your items to the “Compost Pile in Process”. There are always two piles: one that is already broken down and considered “dirt”. This pile is ready to be used as compost. The other pile is the one “in process” that you should add your garden waste or leaves too. The PW Crew mix and stir the pile to assist in the breaking down of the mixture. If there are **Orange Cones** in front of that pile- it means **NOT THIS ONE!!** And sticks are never to be added to the compost pile. Your assistance with this is needed to keep the compost piles in the best usable condition.

Trash and Recycling Carts

All carts need to have at least 3 feet between them when placed at the curb. The space allows the trucks access to pick up containers without knocking others over! Also the lids should always be completely closed when placed on the curb. This keeps the trash from blowing around the village or the wind from catching the lid and knocking the containers over.
