Disposing of old paint?



If the paint is water soluble or latex, you can remove the lid and let the paint dry out in the can. Once the paint is solid put the lid back on and place it in your trash bin. If the can is full of paint, add sand or cat litter to absorb the liquid. Or you can pour the paint out onto newspaper or cardboard, allow it time to dry, and then place it in the trash. This only works for water soluble types of paint.
