WATER BILLS WITH PAST DUE BALANCES



Past Due Balances on Water & Sewer Bills will be added to you or your landlords tax bill on November 1, 2020. Make payments now to avoid the additional 10 % penalty.

PELLITTERI AS NEW TRASH AND RECYCLING CONTRACTOR FOR THE VILLAGE OF DANE

The Village Board of Trustee voted to change the trash and recycling service contractor to PELLITTERI. This service contract will begin January 1, 2021. New carts for both trash and recycling will be distributed to all service users. Watch for a letter to come in the mail from Pellitteri. You will need to respond in a timely fashion to get the cart size you desire. Your current carts will be collected by Advanced Disposal. More information will follow on how that will work.



FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING IN OCTOBER

All fire hydrants in the village will be flushed in October. This process is part of fire hydrant maintenance. Some discoloration or air in the water lines can happen after hydrants are flushed. This is normal; please allow the water to run for a short period of time to alleviate either issue. You may notice a change in water pressure during this time. Thank you.

BRANCH & LIMB COLLECTION

Branch and tree limbs will be collected on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. Upcoming collection dates are October 8, November 12, and December 10, if needed. Please place your limbs and branches on the curb with cut ends toward the curb, in neat piles, and on the day of or day before the collection date.



ELECTRONIC RECYCLING EVENT

The Village of Dane will be hosting an electronic recycling event on Saturday, November 7, 2020 from 8 am to noon in the Village Hall Parking Lot. More information will be out shortly.

Polls for the General Election will be open at 7 am and will remain open until 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3. Voter Registration is available on Election Day. In-person Absentee Voting at Dane Village Hall will begin on Tuesday, October 20, during normal office hours. Please bring your photo ID.

LEAVES, GRASS OR SNOW

The Village Ordinances strictly prohibits anyone from blowing or placing leaves, grass, or snow in the road or along the curb. Be considerate of your neighbor and take care of the leaves that blow off your trees, even when they blow into your neighbor's yard. Burning is allowed in the Village from October 1 through November 15. Burning hours are 6 PM to 6 AM. And never on Sundays, Please!!
