**Kids are back in school** – drivers, please, obey flashing lights in bus loading zones – stopping is mandatory when red lights are flashing- no matter what!

School started this week, and there are several buses that

come to the Village of Dane to pick up and drop off students. Whether you have children who ride the bus or not, you must follow safe driving habits and pay attention to school bus loading and unloading zones. **The intersection of South Street and West Street is a School Bus Zone.** If the bus is there, with the red lights flashing and the stop arm out, you have to stop! It does not matter which direction you are coming from or where you are headed! Be aware of all bus stop zones in the Village!

**A bus stop zone is on North Military Road** just south of the railroad tracks. In this area the bus, by ordinance, uses the yellow hazard lights, and is to be pulled closer to the curb when it stops. At this stop zone, and this one only, cars may continue to drive past the bus in a safe and cautious manner. No child should be in or near the roadway when you proceed past this bus area.

**Burning for fall** starts on October 1 and ends on November 15. There is no open or outdoor burning in the Village of Dane except in compliance with this subsection of the ordinances. Leaves, grasses and garden waste may be burned on private property from April 1 through May 15 and from October 1 through November 15, provided that there shall be no such burning on Sundays and that there shall be no such burning from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on any day. All such burning shall be done in a legal and safe manner, and no such fires shall be left unattended.



**Branch and Limb Pick Up** is on the Second Tuesday ONLY

Limbs are to be placed with cut end to the curb line in neat rows. There should be no other items in the pile; only what can be chipped. Remaining 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesdays are: Oct 9, Nov 13, and Dec 11, if needed.



### All Village Parks Close on October 1

The bathrooms will be locked and the water will be turned off for the winter season. Play areas are still available, as the weather permits.



**Composting** will continue to be available through the fall- use the correct pile, leaves and compost material **ONLY** are to be placed in the compost area. Therefore; no trash, no rocks, no plastic containers, no furniture is to be left at the Public Works Garage- follow the signs and look for the orange cones. Cameras will be watching for violators!



### Delinquent Utility Bills

Accounts with past due balances will be added to the property owners tax bill on November 15, 2018 and will include a 10% penalty on the outstanding balance after November 1 unless paid in full at Village Hall prior to that day.

Letters will be mailed out in mid-October. Tenants and property owners will be notified of past due balances. Tenants with past due accounts must pay the full amount due before November 1 in order to keep the amount from the landlords tax bill.

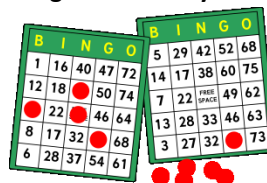


### Euchre on Thursdays
