At the August 3rd Board meeting, Ordinance 2021-03 was adopted. The Ordinance repeals and recreates Section 480-13 of the Village Code of Ordinances regarding Brush Removal. The user-friendly version has been provided on the back of this newsletter. Please keep it handy for a quick reference.

Also adopted at the August 3rd Board meeting was Ordinance 2021-04, repealing and recreating Section 495-20 on parking of certain vehicles. If you
