DELINQUENT BALANCES ON UTILITY BILLS



The Village of Dane Water and Sewer Bills are sent to residents monthly. The due date is clearly stated on the bill. It is expected that balances be paid monthly. Any balance owed after the due date is

subject to a 1% interest charge. This is an annual percentage fee of 12% on unpaid balances. All accounts with past due balances will receive notices in mid-October. The balance will need to be paid in full by October 31, 2021. Any outstanding amounts will have an additional 10% penalty added, and the full amount will be transferred to the real estate property tax bill on November 15, 2021. This action is a state law that applies to municipal owned utilities. Unpaid water bills can be placed as a lien against the property. Please take care of outstanding balances promptly. **THANK YOU!**

FALL BURNING

By village ordinance, burning can be done from October 1 through November 15 each year. Leaves, grass, and garden waste can be burned Monday through Saturday, 6 am to 6 pm and never on Sundays! All such burning needs to be done in a safe manner and no fires shall be left unattended.

Brush and Limb pick up is the second Tuesday of the month: September 14th and October 12th are the next dates for pick up. Rules and guidelines can be found on the village website.



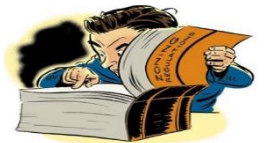
