➤ **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE-DANE STREET**

The Village of Dane is planning the reconstruction of Dane Street due to current roadway and utility conditions. Construction commencing July 2022 and anticipated project completion September 30, 2022.

- Mow your grass, but do not blow it into the street!! This is an ordinance violation and citations can be issued. Plus, the loose grass clogs the storm water system and causes a hazard in the street!
 - Think Safety First!!

- The Village of Dane operates a composting site at the Public Works Facility located at 201 Snyder Drive.

The last pile to the East (left if you are looking at it from the drive) is available free of charge to take for any resident that would like to use it.

The pile all the way to the West (right) is for biodegradable materials.

Please do not dump on or remove product from the center pile.

It is important not to throw plastics as well as other non-biodegradable materials in the pile as this will result in poor final product for yourselves and your fellow residents.
